



Devotional Overview

Genesis Account Staff have prepared devotionals and chapel sessions for our programs. Both will have the same overall topic and we will need your help pouring into the students' lives spiritually.

Morning Devotion: Each morning before classes begin we have a 30-minute cabin devotion time for you and your students. As much as we love to pour into each individual student spiritually we do ask for your support. While our staff prepare for the day, we ask that your chaperones help lead and oversee cabin devotional time.

The morning devotion time may be used to provide time to dig into our theme for the week. It's a good opportunity to talk with the students and see what they are learning and what questions they may have. It's also a great time to seek the Lord in prayer for one another and see what spiritual goals they have for the week. We will provide a devotional for the week that should help guide your time and give direction.

Evening Worship/Chapel: Each evening our staff will lead a 45-60 minute chapel time including praise, worship, and a themed study. The study time utilizes bible stories, discussions, scripture, and testimonies to center the students on their relationship with God.

Praise and Worship: Since our instructors are primarily science and recreation majors, we don't always have the ability to lead worship with musical instruments. Our worship time is led simply, with recorded music and slides to sing along. If your school/church has a strong emphasis in this area, then please feel free to provide what will meet your needs.

Themed Study: Our theme for this year's evening chapel is "Rooted," which is based on Jeremiah 17:7-8.
